Dear Staff Members:

We are pleased to advise you that Governor Cuomo advised on March 10, 2021 that beginning March 17, 2021, public-facing essential building services workers will be eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

We recommend that you schedule the vaccine immediately, subject to advice from your medical professional(s).

In case you are not aware, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), in addition to other health departments, recommend that individuals receive a COVID-19 vaccine:

The CDC has also advised “Studies show that COVID-19 vaccines are effective at keeping you from getting COVID-19. Experts also think that getting a COVID-19 vaccine may help keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19.” Additionally, getting vaccinated likely will be effective in minimizing the chance of your spreading COVID-19 to co-workers, family, friends, and others you encounter.

In addition, please note that New York updated the travel policy for those persons vaccinated:

Domestic travelers to New York State who have been vaccinated no longer have to quarantine or test out within 90 days of their full vaccination. International travelers still must adhere to CDC quarantine guidelines.

Please advise your designated property manager of your intent to schedule the vaccine and if you do, when it is completed.
